To whom it may concern:

Jacobson Gaming has reviewed the mathematical results presented by Harry W. Morris and Lucky Games LLC for the table game Dicey 21 (patent pending), as presented in the document "Dicey 21 Training Manual" using six decks of ordinary playing cards without jokers and three standard 6-sided dice.

This game consists of two wagering opportunities: the "ANTE & RAISE" bet and the "MATCH" bet.

Jacobson Gaming reviewed the ANTE & RAISE bet only and concludes that the House edge, if perfect strategy is used by the Player, is:

- **3.458%** if the payable allows a RAISE of up to **1x** the ANTE for a single Ace;
- **3.138%** if the payable allows a RAISE of up to **2x** the ANTE for a single Ace;
- **2.817%** if the payable allows a RAISE of up to **3x** the ANTE for a single Ace; and
- **2.497%** if the payable allows a RAISE of up to **4x** the ANTE for a single Ace.

All results were obtained by exhaustive spread sheet analysis. All results were confirmed by computer simulations of at least 2 billion rounds using programs written in the C++ programming language.

Jacobson Gaming notes that if either one deck of cards is used, or if the game is dealt from a continuous shuffle machine, the House edge varies by less than 0.1% from the comparable result for six decks. All other mathematical information presented in the above mentioned document was determined to be complete and accurate.
